- Must plan to attend an accredited institution, full time, in Fall of 2025.

Z Club North Bend HS \$1,500.00

Criteria:

- Any field of study is accepted.
- Must be a current member of North Bend High School Z-Club.
- Describe in your narrative response questions how your involvement in Z-Club has impacted you.
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Must plan to attend an accredited institution, full time, in Fall of 2025.

- Must plan to attend accredited institution full time or part time in Fall 2025.

Zonta CB- SWOCC Scholarship

\$3,000.00

Criteria:

- Any field of study is accepted
- Diploma or GED must be from a Coos County High School, or applicant must have lived in Coos County for the past 4 years or more.
- Cumulative GPA must be 2.5 or higher.
- Open to high school or college students.
- Must plan to attend SWOCC full time (min. 12 credits) in Fall 2025.

The following “Trades” scholarship is for certification or licensing in a trade or skill leading to employment.

- Returning student 30 years or older.
- Any technical training is accepted.

International Zonta Women in STEM Award

Criteria:

\$3,000.00

- Women, aged 18-35 years old at the time of application, who demonstrate groundbreaking research, pioneering discoveries and/or exemplary contributions to advancing knowledge and innovation in a **science, technology, engineering or mathematic (STEM) field of study or industry**, are eligible to apply.

International Zonta- Young Women in Leadership Award

Criteria:

\$1,500.00

- Women, aged 16-19 on 1st April each year, living in a Zonta district or who are citizens of a Zonta country, who demonstrate evidence of the following, are eligible to apply.
- Active commitment to volunteerism.
- Experience in local government, student government, or workplace leadership (paid or unpaid).
- Volunteer leadership achievements.
- Knowledge of Zonta International and its programs.
- Support in Zonta International's mission of building a better world for women and girls.

DEADLINE FOR THIS IS **MARCH 15, 2025**, THE APPLICATION CAN BE SUBMITTED TO ZONTA COOS BAY CLUB.

In the event there is no qualifying applicant for a particular scholarship Zonta reserves the right to allocate the funding to another scholarship, or award additional funds to a successful applicant. The scholarship money will be sent to the applicant's school of choice and will not be a cash award. The exception to this is "Young Women In Leadership Award". This is a cash award of \$1,500. with the possibility of winning a \$5,000.00 at the divisional level.

___ Two letters of recommendation, not from a relative. Recommendation letters to include name, title, email and phone number of person writing the letter.
